

CHIEF'S MINUTE(s)

December 8, 2021

- Incidents** – November, 2021 14 total, 3 medical, 4 structure, 1 mva, 3 natural cover, 3 public safety/assist. Structure fires were 1 auto aid to District 2. 1 mutual aid to Tenmile and 1 mutual aid to Camas Valley.
- Training** – Training included final night of salvage/overhaul, safety/OSHA/equipment night, scene preservation, and medical training – vital signs and pt evaluation.
- Firefighters** - Continuing DPSST certifications for Driver Operator and FF1
- Explorers** - Participated in all ff tasks.
- Equipment** - Scheduled annual service and maintenance for 1030, 1031, and 1060 with Mobile Diesel in Sutherlin. Our other past vendors are not doing large trucks anymore. Repaired foam leak on 1080.
- Inventory** - Received new turnouts for 4 firefighters through VFA grant. Washing and inspecting all unassigned PPE. Received butterfly valve, 4 wildland nozzles, two wildland “T”s, and two wildland hose clamps from previous VFA order.
- SCBAs – Scheduled SCBA testing for May of 2022. Conducted quarterly air test of supply system.
- Facility** Salvaging/surplus of old expired turnouts and equipment in storage area continues.
Fuel oil for winter heating at ¾ tank.
Fire extinguishers that were out for hydrostat testing are returned and in service.
- Office/Admin** – SDAO annual conference will be either in person in Eugene or virtual. We have one free admit (\$230) for either. There will be a one day 8 hr Board Member training. Next year's property liability policy is in for review; about a 5% increase will take it to \$8000 approx. Invoice will be due after Jan. 1, 2022. We do have longevity credit also which will give us a \$740 rebate in February of 2022 and 2023.
All position books updated or in the process.
Website up and running, “under construction” but meeting the requirements. Have added fire prevention and safety material, the video drop down with all videos up to date, information sheets on Engine 1030 and Tender 1060. Adding more content weekly. Next will be more quick links to winter fire prevention and safety material.
Deposited the Training refunds for the LPG class and a little over \$43000 in 2021 taxes. Another round due this week.
Disability/accident and group life insurance policy received.
