January 12, 2022

- Incidents** – December, 2021 22 total, 13 medical, 1 structure, 2 mva, 0 natural cover, 3 public safety/assist, 2 False alarms, 1 haz. condition.
Structure fire response was no damage, abandoned house on Seven Springs Rd.
- Training** – Training included safety/OSHA/equipment night, two nights of medical training, and fire attack training at the Dist. 2 drill tower.
- Firefighters** - Finishing up annual medical training for all EMRs/EMTs, recert is this June.
- Explorers** - Participated in all ff tasks.
- Equipment** - Annual service and maintenance for 1030, 1031, and 1060 with Mobile Diesel in Sutherlin completed. Minor repairs completed as needed, 1030 and 1060 are in good shape, 1031 has a laundry list of items that will be scheduled with MDS or our local repair business (Maverick)
- Inventory** - Paid invoice for final VFA purchase. Following up with State Forestry for changes to grant and final submission of forms for reimbursement. Was extended until February.
SCBAs – Air test for our cascade system back, passed. Met with Cascade Fire, they will still handle our required mask Fit testing in future at a reduced price.
- Facility** Salvaging/surplus of old expired turnouts and equipment in storage area continues.
Auxiliary generator and station generator ran and maintained. Station operated for 3 hours during power outage.
- Office/Admin** – SDAO annual conference will be virtual only in February. Next year's property liability policy invoice is in and due March 1st, will have it ready for payment at February meeting. Longevity credit rebate due in February also.
Website up and running, "under construction" but meeting the requirements. Continue to update and add new material.
Deposited more of 2021 taxes, majority are now in.
Christmas "Secret Santa" for 2021 was food gift cards to the school. Joined with the Grange and distributed \$500 worth.
Working on grants with Dist.2 for radios, ourselves for new 1031, and a joint grant with Tenmile for volunteer recruitment and retention.
