

## CHIEF'S MINUTE(s)

May 11, 2022

- Incidents** – April, 2022 30 total, 15 medical, 1 structure, 2 mva, 0 natural cover, 12 public safety/assist, 0 false alarms, 0 haz. condition. Structure fire was in our area, \$2 million damage total to 8000 sq. ft. dwelling with 3 vehicles in attached garage, cause is undetermined at this time and under investigation. Fire District 2 provided auto aid, 2 engines and tender and 1 Battalion Chief.
- Training** – Training included safety meeting/officers meeting and vehicle checks, wildland urban interface/structure protection, annual wildland RT130 refresher training with DFPA, and water supply/flow/RIT training at the Melrose drill tower. Critique/review of Silvercrest fire.
- Firefighters** - Recertifying and licensing Emergency Medical Responders. Two ffs certified at State level in passenger and heavy vehicle technical rescue. Two certified and on USFS list as fellers/cutters. Participated with Umpqua Valley Ambulance in additional rope rescue training. Final planning on May 21 wildland drill.
- Explorers** - Participated in all ff tasks.
- Equipment** - Installed light bar, emergency lights, and siren on 1091. Repaired gauges on 1031. Annual service completed on emergency generator and OES generator with Maverick Mobile repair.
- Inventory** - Received additional structural and wildland PPE for firefighters, adaptors for wildland connections to USFS and DFPA.
- Facility** Received and setting up new monitor, projector, and screen as budgeted for training room. Bought Chromecast device for training, casting existing materials to monitor.
- Office/Admin** – All Department computers up and running on Microsoft 365, daily scanned for viruses and malware, doing monthly full scans as recommended by recent training. Updating as it scans. Using multi factor authentication where we can. Backing up on external hard drives.  
2022-23 Workers Comp package returned to SDAO, will be invoiced in June.  
Submitted new VFA grant for approximately \$19,800 of PPE, vehicle maintenance, and training reimbursement. Still working on SPIRE State grant for emergency seismic supplies.  
Budget process in progress, have had first meeting, public notices and forms completed, next meeting May 23 with Budget Hearing before June 8 Board Meeting.
